

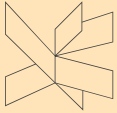
Healthcare in a global community

International nursing semester

Do you want a unique experience in Denmark? To study theory and have practical placements in a Danish hospital and in community nursing? Then join the exchange program in nursing leadership, management and care –meeting the healthcare needs in a global society in the 21st Century.

During the semester, students from many different countries will learn with, from and about each other to develop knowledge and skills in an inter-professional health and social care context.

Students become part of an international community with international students from different disciplines and participate in many social and cultural activities.



PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Duration: 1 semester

ECTS: 30 ECTS

Language: English

Programme period: August- December

Study place: VIA University College, Campus Viborg, Denmark.

Content:

The semester consists of three units:

1. Nursing Leadership and management of the chronically ill and community nursing
2. Inter-professional Collaboration
3. Nursing Leadership and management of the acutely ill.

For each unit, different types of teaching methods and course assessment (e.g. closed exam, written essay, oral exam, clinical assessment) are applied. During the semester students will also have 4-week practical work in hospital and 2 weeks clinical in community.

Tuition fee: Exchange students pay no tuition fee if they come from institutions with a partner agreement with VIA University College.

Application deadline: 15 March

Campus location and housing: Campus Viborg is located in Central Jutland. Continuously, international students from more than 100 countries worldwide come to study at Campus Viborg. The campus offers students' house and can assist with accommodation.

Social activities: The students can participate in various social and cultural events in Viborg to expand their knowledge of Denmark. The city of Viborg is only one-hour drive from the City of Aarhus, Denmark's second largest city.
