How to Connect Your Computer or Mobile Device to VIA's Wireless Network "VIA"

This user manual applies to students and external users on locations with access to the wireless network "VIA". Employees who wish to access the wireless network from other devices than their VIAcomputer (e.g. mobile phone) can use this user manual as well.


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Windows 7:

Run an automatic configuration of your computer. You can do this by choosing the wireless net called VIAguest when you are located at one of VIA's addresses.







2. Click on the network "VIA".





Input your VIAID address and password and click "Join".
