



Statements exposure



Goal of the exposure.

The aim of this statements exposure is to talk about certain statements so that different views come to light. In this way te educators can gain new insights about the statements and take this into practice.

What do you need to play the game?

- Cards with the statements (see bellow)
- Below you find the different stements according to 3 thems. (colours)
- You also find the colours on the game board.

How to play the game?

You can play the game in different ways

- You can play it in combination with a other exposure
- You can play it with the game board where you follow the different themes by coloring
- You can play only one theme

One of the educators picks a card with a statement. He/she reads the statement out loud. Every participant gets a few minutes to think about this in silence. The person who drew the card starts by formulating his opinion about the statement. Everyone does this in turn and the others just listen. When everyone has had their turn, it is discussed each other?

Supplement: You can also add statements that you made yourself depending on your own context.





Statements related to hospitality:

- Hospitality is connecting and making contact.
- Hospitality requires an appropriate distance.
- Hospitality has no limits.
- Hospitality is more than guest orientation.
- Every student must make their voice heard.
- Hospitality is a snapshot.
- Group formation can stand in the way of a hospitable moment.
- Hospitality is culture-bound.
- Values and standards of host and guest are related to the extent to which you can be hospitable.
- As a host you always have to adapt to the guest.
- Hospitality is overrated.
- Hospitality towards colleagues is not the same as hospitality towards students.





Statements related to diversity

- Treat the guest the way you want to be treated yourself.

- There is only 1 person who can determine whether you are hospitable.
- Hospitality is universal and goes beyond all religions.
- I can be myself in a group.
- I feel safe in a new group.
- As a teacher, I sometimes catch myself that I have prejudices towards students.
- As a teacher, I am objective towards all students.
- As a teacher, you have to open yourself up to students to gain their trust.
- As a teacher, you can be yourself within a group of students.
- As a teacher, you have to stand next to your students.
- As a teacher, you are only human.
- As a teacher, you can be hospitable to every student, even if it is a very diverse group.

Statements related to communication

- Hospitality is always keep on smiling, even if you don't feel well.
- Your personality as a host is crucial in hospitality.
- You can agree that you do not agree with each other.

- Positive feedback from supervisors is necessary for teachers to ensure an open attitude towards their students.

- Straightforward communication promotes hospitality.
- An overload of information can get in the way of hospitality.
- To be hospitable, we have to speak the same language.
- You can not not communicate.
- Look at your own practice through the eyes of your guest.
- Hospitality is very much black and white and little grey.
- You never have a second chance to make a first impression.

- Communication is not so much about sending and receiving, but about understanding and connecting.
